Travelling to Asklepios Klinik Harburg

Asklepios Klinik Harburg is located south of the river Elbe in Harburg / Eißendorf.

- By car:** Take A1 (E22), exit „Harburg“, take B73 westbound, then A7 (E45), exit „Heimfeld“, then B73 eastbound.
- Hamburg Airport:** located about 25 km from Asklepios Klinik Harburg, easily reachable via highway A7, exit „Stellingen“ or „Schnelsen“.
- By train:** Take S-Bahn S3/S31 from Hamburg Central Station, exit „Heimfeld“. Our hospital is a 10-minute-walk from „Heimfeld“. Alternatively you may take Bus 142, direction „Hans-Dewitz-Ring – via AK Harburg“. Some ICE trains stop directly in Hamburg-Harburg.



What to bring

If you are being admitted for a planned procedure or operation you will have time to pack a small bag. We recommend you include:

- Letters from your doctor about your admission
- The medicine you are taking
- sanitary items, if applicable shaving material
- Dressing gown, slippers and nightwear
- Day clothes – a tracksuit or other comfortable clothes
- A small amount of money for papers, snacks and drinks
- Any walking aids you use

You will have a small bedside locker to keep your belongings in, but don't bring any valuables. We cannot accept responsibility for any loss of property while you are with us.

Treatment

Before you have any treatment the doctor or nurse will explain what is planned and ask if you have any questions. We cannot, by law, carry out any operation or procedure without your informed consent unless it is an emergency or you are unconscious. If you have any questions, worries or concerns about your treatment or care please speak to a member of staff. We will provide you with medical interpreters if necessary.

Privata ward

You will find your accomodation on the top floor of the main building, offering beautiful views over the surrounding forest to the skyline of Hamburg. The rooms are light-filled, comfortable single rooms and are equipped with modern entertainment and communication systems – such as LCD TV, internet, DVD player and telephone. Each room offers private sanitary facilities with high-quality comfort features. Catering will be provided via a separate menu with a wide range of food and beverages to choose from. Our visitors' lounge also offers a selection of literature.

Costs for your stay

After reviewing your documents we will send you a non-binding estimate of costs for your stay and treatment in our hospital. The cost of the treatment has to be paid in advance to our bank account.
