

Therapy

In addition to the medical treatment, we also utilise the entire range of interventional procedures such as laser therapy or stent implants. We work with open and minimally invasive thoracic surgery.

Our range of treatments is supplemented by an interdisciplinary, special intensive medicine unit for long-term and home respiration (certified weaning centre), night-time breathing regulation disorders (DGSM-accredited sleep lab) and pain therapy.

At our oncological day clinic we are able to provide partial inpatient treatment.
